Focus on Ministry-HOSPITALITY!

I was asked this month to write about our Ministry Team. I came across this article written by Scott Cormode on faithward.org, and it really touched home with me: "Hospitality is a Christian practice that extends all the way back to the Book of Genesis. Although in contemporary Western culture, people use the term to mean catering a meal or putting on a party, hospitality means far more as a Christian practice. Hospitality is the offer to extend the privileges of community to those who do not have the standing to expect it, especially those who are vulnerable because they are strangers. Hospitality often involves sharing meals, but hospitality is about more than eating. Eating is, for example, one of the privileges of being in my family. My kids have the right to expect to be fed every single night. When I share a meal with them, it is not an act of kindness. I owe it to them. When I share such a meal with an outsider, I invite them into my family for that brief period. Hospitality is an offer to identify with outsiders and to treat them like insiders. Hospitality is extending privilege across difference."

A Little Bit About the Hospitality Ministry Team

The Hospitality Ministry team's job is to make our church a warm, welcoming environment for people to worship and find Christ. We strive to create opportunities for members to not only get to know one another and enjoy various fun activities, but to open the door for our members to invite friends outside of church to these activities. As we know, our mission statement is "Making Disciples of Christ." What better way to expose our "outside friends" with our faith and church family than a fun event like a soup lunch, game night, or one of the many other activities we host.

So, what is the Hospitality Ministry team currently involved in?

- Keeping the Hospitality Visitors' cart organized and stocked with visitor gifts,
- Putting together welcome gift bags for new members.
- Coordination of, and participation in, the new Coffee Hour Service Team.
- Keeping the kitchen stocked with supplies for coffee hour and other Hospitality events.
- Manage a Sysco (food ordering) account for the church and assist other ministry teams in ordering food.
- Sponsored and maintain the Turquoise Table by the Community Garden.
- Design and create the float and coordinate the volunteers for the Hartford Christmas Parade.
- Coordinate meals for Messy Church and Vacation Bible School.
- Plan and host the Advent Luncheon, soup lunches, ecumenical meals, ice cream socials, and to-go chicken dinners.
- New this summer coordinate a monthly grill out/potluck for Thursday night casual outdoor service.
- Greet visitors and make them feel welcome and at home.

I know a lot of the things we do are centered around food because if you have food, people will come. People love to commune with each other at the table. Food is heart; we need it to survive, but it is also a wonderful way to show hospitality. I personally feel it is a very non- confrontational way to show our love to others and make them feel comfortable at our church, so we can then take the next step and show them our love of Christ.

Our team is divided into sub-teams, because many hands make light work!

Part-time member is responsible for the ministry position/job they have chosen to do. They generally do not need to attend any meetings unless their event requires it (e.g., Advent Luncheon). They are not expected to assist in any additional events unless they choose to.

Flex member may or may not have a sub-team responsibility but are willing to assist in any of the events we sponsor, as well as the special areas they are in charge of. They also attend our meetings as needed. We meet approximately 6-8 times a year.

Victoria Triick – Team Coordinator and Flex member; in charge of name badges and all things hospitality, especially in the kitchen.

Jeanne Konrad – Flex member; handles advertising with Chamber of Commerce and Washington Country Board of Tourism; provides updates to the FUMC informational pamphlet; and handles our budget. She is a busy lady and my right hand. (Continued on the next page)

Finance Team Update

Since the beginning of the year, expenses of the church have exceeded income by about \$19,000. It is normal for the church to have a deficit in the first months of the year. Fortunately, robust giving at the end of 2021 provided a reserve. Our current operating balance is about \$43,000. Please keep up your support of the operating budget as we move into the summer months.

Because we were unable to find someone from the congregation to act as treasurer for 2022, we contracted with Vickney & Associates to produce monthly financial reports. Unfortunately, that did not work out. We recalled the work from Vickney. Finance Team Lead and Acting Treasurer Rod Bartlow and Pastor Cheryl worked together to produce reports for January through March.

Moving forward, assigning full responsibility for accounting to the office staff would put an unexpected burden on them. Denise Schlotthauer has volunteered to enter data to the accounting workbooks. At month end Rod will review the files and issue the financial reports.

In the April newsletter we reported we had met our goal of raising \$100,000 in the Recipe for Repayment campaign. A few more contributions have come in and our plan is to pay off the building loan at the end of April. Thank you again to everyone who contributed to this effort.

Technology Update

We have decided on a contractor for the purchase and installation of a new screen, projector and audio-visual equipment in the sanctuary. The order has been placed and we are awaiting feedback on delivery/installation time frames. Additionally, the trustees are working with Drew Lichtensteiger to build a larger technology booth to replace the one we have. Thanks Trustees and Drew. We are also purchasing 2 portable 60-incvh monitors for use anywhere in the church and another monitor to be mounted at the back of the sanctuary for pastor, liturgists and choir members to follow along with what is projected on the main sanctuary screen.

Relative to the office, we have ordered replacement computers and software for Pastor, Robin, Emilee, Brittany and our treasurer. We are also replacing the computer in the technology booth. We are working with the vendor right now to schedule delivery and training for the computers. Once we get the computers replaced, we will begin assessing other technology upgrades for the church, such as security cameras, phone upgrades, website upgrade, social media, etc.

The meeting was called to order and opened with a prayer.

Spiritual Learning

Pastoral Updates

Maundy Thursday worship will include a potluck at 6:00 p.m. and worship at 7:00.

Good Friday services are scheduled for 1:00 and 7:00 p.m.

Easter worship at 8:30 a.m., Easter Breakfast at 9:30 prepared by Youth and 10:45 worship to follow. Last Messy Church will be 5/4 until we resume in the fall.

Sunday 5/15 will be one service at 9:30 with an end of Sunday School celebration in Fellowship Hall. This will begin our summer worship schedule with one 9:30 service on Sunday. Thursday evening worship will begin on June 2nd.

Finance Team

Financial reporting will stay with the church and not be outsourced to Vickney. Summary Green Sheets were shared. Receipts are running slightly behind payment through January and February.

ShelbyNext, a financial and church management software is being researched.

We have received around \$120,000 for the Building Loan Challenge. This will allow us to pay off the loan balance. Additional donations will be transferred to the Building and Maintenance Fund.

Technology Update

New office laptops have been ordered and are waiting for a delivery date.

The sanctuary sound equipment and projector have been ordered and are also waiting for a delivery date. Quotes for the new AV corner booth were shared and a decision made.

Trustees

The property survey will be completed by the end of the month.

A dumpster will be delivered to the church on 4/4 for use with the lower level clean up.

Spring projects are being planned.

Ministry Team Updates

Christian Education—VBS will be June 20th thru 23rd.

Mission—"Rice Pack" planning in progress.

Hospitality—served over 100 people at Ecumenical Soup meal. Coffee Hour teams are being developed. Details in the upcoming newsletter.

Worship—no refreshments will be served after Thursday night worship this summer.

Faith Groups—Saving Grace book study will move to the fall. Serenity Prayer book group has 15 participants and is going well.
